
Overview of Alumni Speak Sessions



Report: Placement Assistance Workshop

The Placement Assistance Workshop was conducted with the aim of providing valuable guidance and insights to students for their placement journey. The workshop was coordinated by Dr. Gopal Krishna Sharma and Sharad Raj Maurya (MCA, Semester-3) and featured Mr. Pranav Sharma, a senior software developer from SelfDecode, San Francisco, as the keynote speaker.

The workshop commenced with a collective recitation of the Gayatri Mantra, creating a positive and focused environment. Dr. Gopal Krishna Sharma and Sharad Raj Maurya provided an introduction, emphasizing the significance of the workshop and encouraging students to make the most of the opportunity to enhance their skills for placement.

Mr. Pranav Sharma, a highly experienced professional in the software development industry, was introduced as the speaker for the session. His achievements and expertise in both technical and managerial aspects were highlighted, further establishing his credibility.

Key points of discussion were:

- **1. Skills:** Mr. Pranav Sharma emphasized the importance of skills in the placement process. He explained that companies evaluate an individual's skills based on their past projects, categorizing skills into three tiers: good, average, and beginner. Attendees were advised to choose a career path aligned with their passion.
- **2. Communication:** Effective communication skills were stressed as crucial during interviews and interactions with potential employers. Mr. Pranav Sharma highlighted the significance of clear and articulate communication in making a positive impression.
- **3. Discipline:** The need for discipline was emphasized in terms of time management, meeting deadlines, and maintaining professionalism. Mr. Pranav Sharma spoke on the importance of a disciplined approach throughout the placement process.

Skills were discussed in detail, with Mr. Pranav Sharma presenting an Al engineer roadmap to demonstrate the progression of skills in the field. Attendees were encouraged to

continually add new skills to their resumes, and it was explained that learning a new topic becomes easier once proficiency is achieved in a specific programming language. The speaker also discussed common skills that individuals should possess and inquired if anyone had added a new repository to their Git or completed any programming language-based projects.

The importance of a well-structured resume was highlighted, with Mr. Pranav Sharma emphasizing the role of keywords in making a resume effective. Attendees were advised to highlight their qualifications and skills in their resumes.

Mr. Pranav Sharma provided valuable insights and tips for interview preparation. He stressed the significance of effectively describing one's projects and past work experiences, answering common interview questions by highlighting relevant aspects related to the job. He also advised attendees to present their weaknesses as strengths and articulate why they would be beneficial to the company based on its direction. The importance of maintaining a positive and learning-oriented attitude throughout the interview process was emphasized.

During the Q&A session, attendees had the opportunity to ask questions on various topics, such as cracking FAANG company interviews, choosing a programming language, the necessity of official documentation for projects, and applying for internships. Mr. Pranav Sharma answered these questions, providing guidance on seeking advice from others, utilizing online resources like Google, and referring to roadmap websites for specific goals.

He encouraged attendees to apply for jobs even if they lacked some of the required skills, emphasizing the importance of continuous learning and personal growth. The workshop provided valuable insights and guidance to students, equipping them with the necessary knowledge and skills for.

At the end of the Placement Assistance Workshop, Dr. Gopal Krishna Sharma and Mr. Sharad Raj Maurya on behalf of the students expressed gratitude to Mr. Pranav Sharma for his insightful session and valuable guidance, they acknowledged the immense contribution of Mr. Pranav Sharma in sharing his expertise and experiences, which would greatly benefit the students in their placement.
