



# Bridging Ancient Wisdom with Contemporary Science for Future Generations



# **Research Framework**

Students may engage in empirical and/or theoretical research using extensive literature, scientific papers, classical text analysis, Field Studies, etc., through different Qualitative, Quantitative, and Mixed Methods.

# **Outcomes from Job Prospects**

Students shall develop expertise in their specific area of research related to Indigenous Approaches for Child Development and Generational Dynamics, which can prepare them for:

Early Childhood Researchers: Work in universities, research institutions, or think tanks focusing on child development, educational psychology, or generational studies.

Policy Analysts: Contribute to creating child-friendly policies for the government bodies (e.g., NITI Aayog, Ministry of Women and Child Development) or international organizations (UNICEF, UNESCO).

Doctoral Studies: Pursue a Ph.D. in developmental psychology, generational studies, or education policy.

Generational Behavior Consultants: Work with companies to improve intergenerational workplace dynamics, especially with younger employees like Gen Z and Alpha.

Prenatal and Postnatal Wellness Coaches: Start services for expectant parents that combine Garbh Sanskar, yoga, mindfulness, and modern techniques.

Content Creators: Develop books, videos, or courses on parenting, child development, or intergenerational harmony.




# **Eligibility Criteria**

The eligibility criteria for this 1-year/2-semester PG program, at level 6.5 on the NHEQF

4-year bachelor's degree with Honors or Honors with Research With a minimum of 160 credits
In any field of study (passed with a minimum 50% marks)

4 year technical, or any other professional degree with a minimum of 160 credits (passed with minimum 50% marks),



Master's degree, at level 6.5 on the NHEQF, in any field of study (passed with minimum 50% marks)

Age limit - 30 years [a relaxation of up to 10 years in age (i.e. up to the age of 40 years) may be given to those who have constantly been in some occupation, and can provide a proof of constantly being in job that made it difficult for them to apply earlier]




