Reservation Policy for Admission in Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya (DSVV) – As per Uttarakhand State Government Guidelines

1. Introduction: Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya (DSVV) is committed to ensuring inclusive and equitable education by implementing the reservation policy as per the guidelines of the Uttarakhand State Government for private universities. This policy outlines the reservation criteria applicable to various courses at the university.

2. Categories of Reservation (As per Uttarakhand Government Norms):

- **Scheduled Castes (SC):** 19% of the total seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes.
- **Scheduled Tribes (ST):** 4% of the total seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes.
- **Other Backward Classes (OBC - Non-Creamy Layer):** 14% of the total seats shall be reserved for OBC candidates.
- **Economically Weaker Sections (EWS):** 10% reservation shall be provided to candidates belonging to the EWS category as per state government guidelines.
- **Persons with Disabilities (PwD):** 5% horizontal reservation shall be provided to candidates with disabilities across all categories.
- **Women Candidates:** 30% horizontal reservation shall be provided to female candidates across all categories.
- **Dependents of Freedom Fighters (DFF):** 2% horizontal reservation shall be provided to dependents of freedom fighters.
- **Ex-Servicemen/Defense Personnel Wards:** 5% horizontal reservation shall be provided for dependents of ex-servicemen and defense personnel.
- **State Quota (Uttarakhand Domicile):** 40% of total seats shall be reserved for candidates who are permanent residents of Uttarakhand.

3. Eligibility and Documentation:

- Candidates claiming reservation benefits must submit valid certificates issued by the competent authorities in Uttarakhand at the time of admission.
- OBC candidates must provide a non-creamy layer certificate issued within the last financial year as per Uttarakhand government regulations.
- EWS candidates must provide an income and asset certificate issued by the state government.
- PwD candidates must provide a valid disability certificate issued by a recognized medical authority in Uttarakhand.
- Dependents of freedom fighters and ex-servicemen must provide proof of their claim issued by the appropriate state government department.

4. Seat Allocation Process and Calculation Formula:

- The reservation policy shall be applied during the seat allocation process while ensuring that merit remains a primary criterion.
- The number of reserved seats for each category is calculated using the following formula:

For example, if a course has 100 seats:

- SC Seats = $(100 \times 19) / 100 = 19$ seats
 - ST Seats = $(100 \times 4) / 100 = 4$ seats
 - OBC Seats = $(100 \times 14) / 100 = 14$ seats
 - EWS Seats = $(100 \times 10) / 100 = 10$ seats
 - Uttarakhand Domicile Seats = $(100 \times 40) / 100 = 40$ seats
- If the total number of seats is not a whole number, rounding shall be done based on university norms.
 - In case reserved seats remain unfilled due to the non-availability of eligible candidates, they may be converted to the general category as per the university's admission policy.

5. Amendments and Updates:

- The university reserves the right to amend this policy as per changes in Uttarakhand government regulations and guidelines.
- Any disputes related to reservations shall be resolved by the university's admission committee in consultation with the state education authorities.

This policy ensures compliance with the Uttarakhand State Government guidelines while upholding the principles of social justice and inclusivity at Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya.

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
