Policy Title: Green Campus and Plastic-Free Initiative
Effective Date:1st July 2020
Review Date: 1st January 2025

### 1. Purpose

The University is committed to fostering a sustainable environment by promoting eco-friendly practices and reducing plastic waste. This policy outlines our commitment to creating a green campus while eliminating single-use plastics.

## 2. Scope

This policy applies to all university stakeholders, including students, faculty, staff, and visitors, across all university properties and events.

## 3. Policy Statement

The University aims to:

- Create an environmentally sustainable campus.
- Educate the university community about sustainability and waste reduction.
- Eliminate the use of single-use plastics within the university.

## 4. Implementation Strategies

### A. Green Campus Initiatives
